Creator's Corner

PAINTER/TEACHER

A. Thomas O'Grady 1939 - 2022

Austin Thomas O'Grady, 82, passed away on May 30, 2022 Tom was born August 11, 1939, in St. Louis, Mo.

He was raised in Cuba and attended Cuba Central School where he became interested in art and began his lifelong passion of painting, giving credit to his art teacher Cuba's Chet Swier. Upon graduation Tom enrolled in Buffalo



State College majoring in Art Education and graduated in 1961. He began his teaching career with Allegany County BOCES teaching art in grades K-6 at Rushford Central School and grades 7-12 at Scio Central School. In 1962 he joined the Scio faculty full-time to establish a grade 7-12 art program. He earned his Master of Science degree in 1967 from Alfred University. Tom taught art at Scio for 34 years and grew the program to include photography, mechanical and architectural drafting, in addition to art. He was the founding chair of the Art Department and served until 1995 when he was named K-12 principal. He retired in 2000.

Tom was also an accomplished watercolor artist and received many national and international awards and recognition. His work has been exhibited in the NYS Governor's mansion, the Portrait Gallery in Washington, D.C., United States Embassies in Rome, Italy and Australia, in the J. Barret Galleries in Toledo, Ohio, the Albright-Knox Gallery in Buffalo and the MGM Grand Gallery in Las Vegas, Nevada. In 1975, he was commissioned by Allegany County to design and sculpt the County's Bicentennial Medallion. His artwork is in many private collections including that of former President, Jimmy Carter.

Tom was an avid member of the community participating in many activities. He was the charter president of the Wellsville Art Association, a charter member of the Genesee Valley Chorus, and a charter

member of the Great Wellsville Balloon Rally Committee. For 25 years his balloon poster paintings highlighted the Wellsville area and its rural landscape and set the standard for future artists. He has been credited with influencing the current Balloon Rally artist. Many former students also give credit to Tom O'Grady for their own art expertise and love of art.

He is survived by his wife, Roseanna, three sons, eight grandchildren, three great-grandchildren; and a sister, Ann Kubiniec as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

He is buried in St. Bonaventure Cemetery in Allegany,

We believe that art is not a luxury but a necessity. The Arts Access program was created to remove the barriers that prohibit many Western New Yorkers from experiencing the arts, including cost, transportation, language, and effort. Any individual or family who receives income based public assistance in WNY is eligible to apply. 
